Key Stage 2 SATs results

Following the changes in assessment made by the Department for Education this year; children are no longer given a level at the end of key stage 2. The new assessment arrangements show if the children are working at the new Age Related expectations [ARE]. There is also a 'high score' judgment for those pupils who perform particularly strongly in the assessments.

In addition to this there is a scaled score for each subject which can be between 80-120 with 100 being the expected level.

The number of children assessed at the end of Key Stage 2 was 21.
