Intent of expenditure for academic year 2016/17:

- Specialist PE person to cover PPA
- Teacher training on specific areas to help develop the quality of teaching.
- Free after school Games Club to increase PE and Sport participation across the school (Arsenal Sports Coaching).
- Continuation of swimming provision of swimming children for all Key Stage 2 children Year 3 - Year 6
- Sports equipment purchases/upgrades.
- Gifted and talented opportunities - developing those children who show a particular aptitude to sport.

How has the PE and Sport Premium grant made a difference to our school?

We are continuing to work closely with one of the leading PE and sports coaching companies,

Teachers have, and will continue, to benefit from numerous training on a range of sports helping them to develop their PE and sports skills which in return has enhanced and developed the children's learning in these sessions.

Increase in participation of sport during after school clubs. Children continue to enjoy the opportunity to take part in various free after school clubs delivered by school staff. Children are encouraged to have fun while exercising with football, dodge-ball, hockey, tennis, high 5 netball, rounders and tag rugby delivered throughout the term.

Daily lunchtime activities set up by staff and school play leaders has been extremely popular with the children helping to achieve more PE and sport

participation. Activities vary offering a range of events for all abilities and ages.

High quality swimming provision for children from Year 3 has begun. Any children that needs additional swimming slots are targeted. With the assistance of the PE and Sport grant we have been able to offer free transport to and from the swimming swimming pool. This is supplemented by the school budget in order to give parents every opportunity for the children to take part swimming at no cost.

Children who have a particular sporting talent are offered extra opportunities to take part in training and competitions. The federation has a designated Gifted and Talented Co-ordinator for this purpose.

Sporting equipment is being continually updated making sure that high quality equipment is available for all classes to use.
