PE and Sport Premium for Primary Schools 2018/19

(1st instalment 2018 - 2019 £7,342)

Intent of expenditure for academic year 2018/19:

- Daily lunchtime sports provided by external company 'Saints South West Sports Coaching'.
- Teacher insets on specific areas to help develop the quality of teaching (KS1/2: basic ball skills, invasions games, football, athletics and dance. Foundation Stage: introduction to PE and to learn basic fundamental skills) - delivered by 'Saints South West'
- Free After School Games Club to increase PE and Sport participation across the school (Saints South West Sports Coaching).
- Continuation of swimming provision for children from Year 1 - Year 6
- Sports equipment purchases/upgrades.
- Gifted and talented opportunities - developing those children who show a particular aptitude to sport.

How has the PE and Sport Premium grant made a difference to our school?

We are continuing to work closely with one of the leading PE and sports coaching companies, Saints South West Sports School, to raise the level of achievement reached by pupils as well as working alongside teachers to increase their subject knowledge and confidence.

Teachers have, and will continue, to benefit from numerous training on a range of sports helping them to develop their PE and sports skills which in return has enhanced and developed the children's learning in these sessions.

Increase in participation of sport during after school clubs. Children continue to enjoy the opportunity to take part in various free after school clubs delivered by Saints South West and school staff. Children relish the opportunity to take part in free after school clubs delivered by an external organisation 'Saints South West Soccer School'. Being able to provide a free football club for all years has been very popular and club sizes have increased with good participation throughout the school.

Daily lunchtime activities set up by Saints South West Soccer and school play-leaders has been popular with the children helping to achieve more PE and sport participation. Activities vary offering a range of events for all abilities and ages.

Across the federation we offer high quality swimming provision for all children with each class continuing to have their statutory 3 x hours of lessons per year. We secured extra swimming slots/instructors at Newton Abbot Leisure Centre Swimming Pool reserved for children that require additional support with their water confidence. The PE and Sport premium fund has helped finance transport costs to and from the swimming pool. This is supplemented by the school budget in order to give parents every opportunity for the children to take part in swimming at no cost.

90% of Year 6 children in 2017 could swim 25 metres. We will be assessing current Year 6 children during the Summer Term 2018.

Children who have a particular sporting talent are offered extra opportunities to take part in training and competitions with other schools and organisations.

Sporting equipment is being continually updated making sure that high quality equipment is available for all classes to use.
